Αύριο ανοίγει η σημαντική ΕΚΘΕΣΗ ΕΙΚΑΣΤΙΚΩΝ ΚΑΛΛΙΤΕΧΝΩΝ ΤΗΣ ΣΑΓΚΑΗΣ ΣΤΗΝ ΑΘΗΝΑ

που διοργανώνει το Επιμελητήριο Εικαστικών Τεχνών Ελλάδος σε συνεργασία με την Ένωση Εικαστικών Καλλιτεχνών Σαγκάης.

Την εκδήλωση υποστηρίζει η Ανωτάτη Σχολή Καλών Τεχνών της Αθήνας. 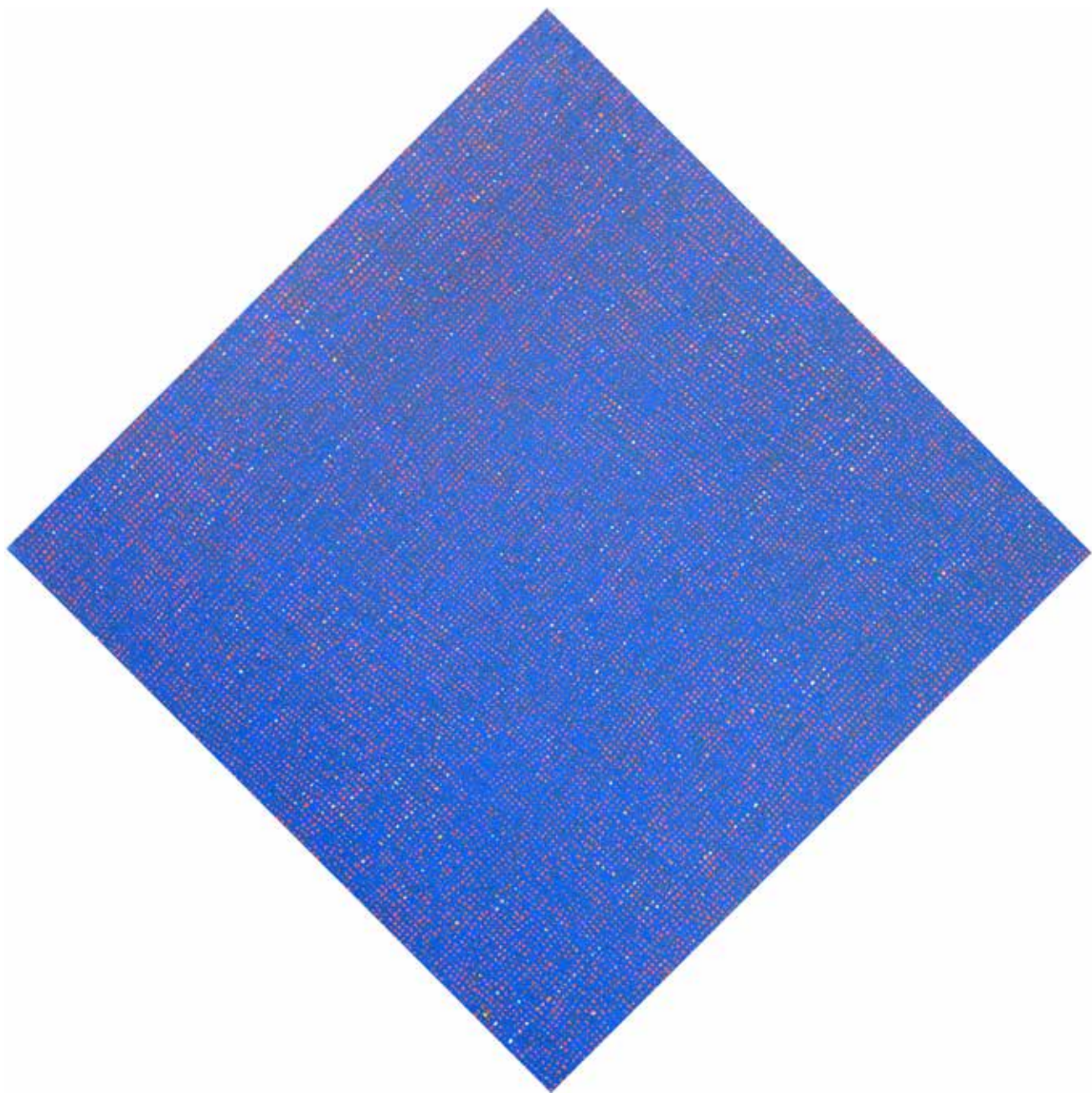

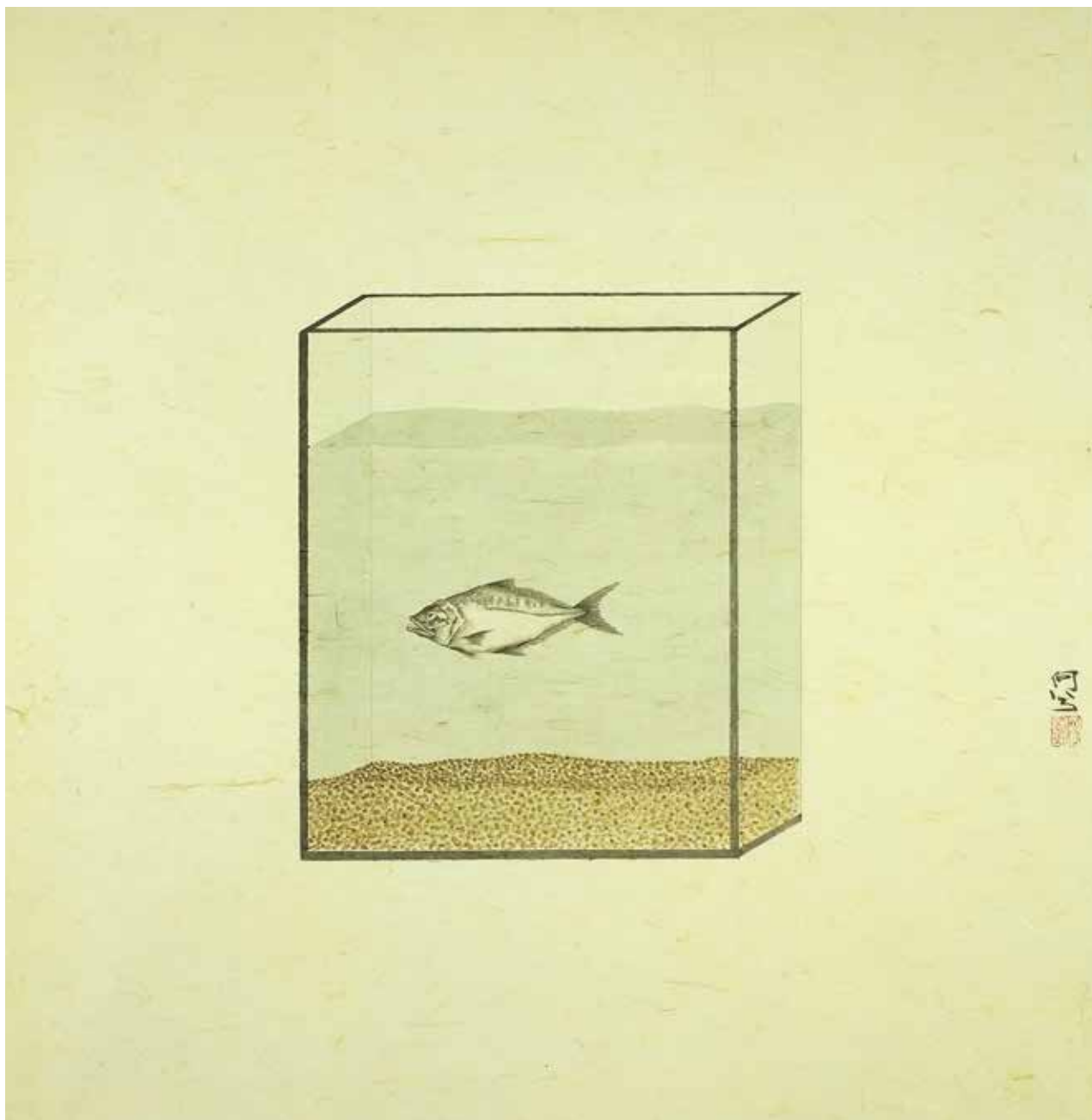

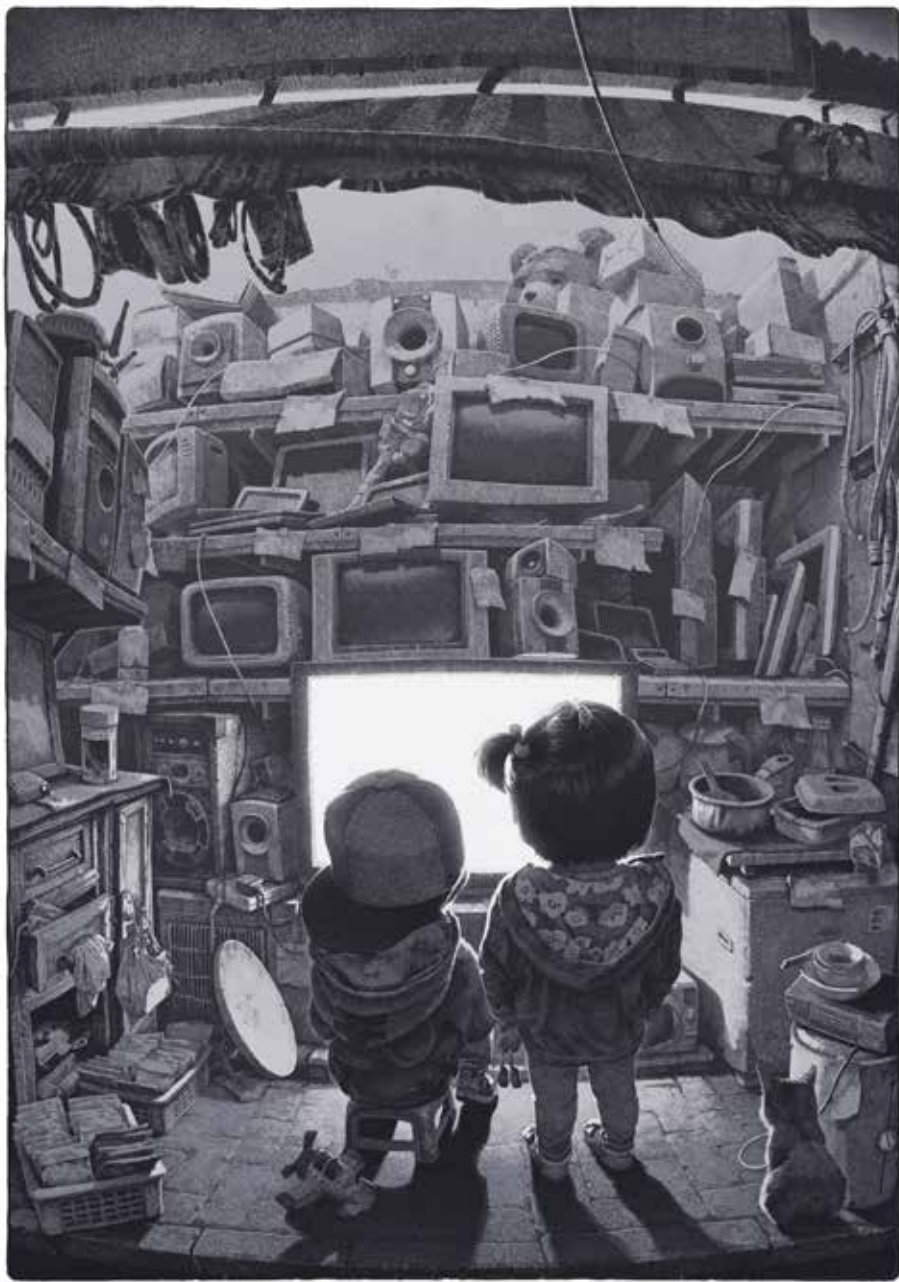

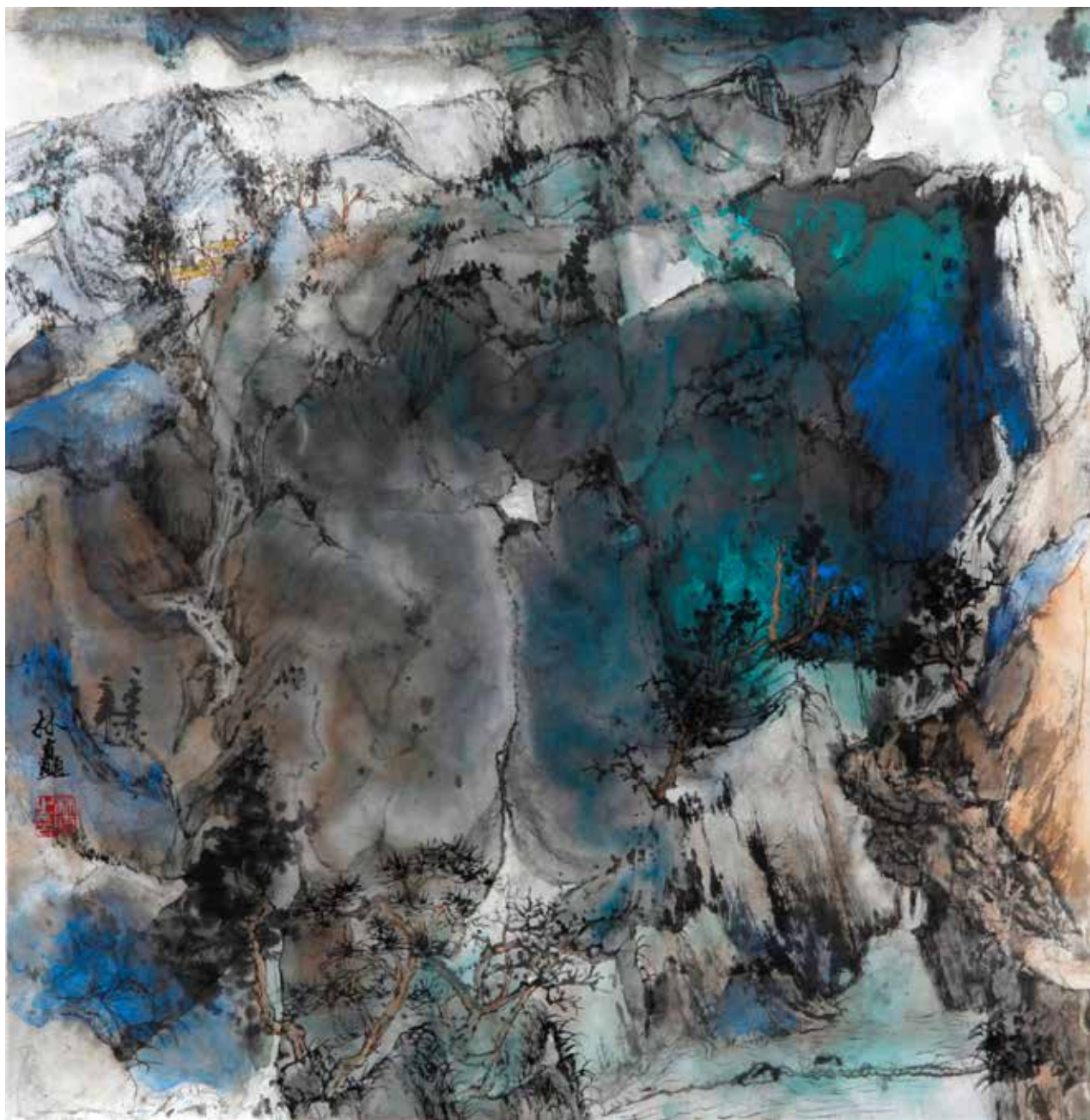

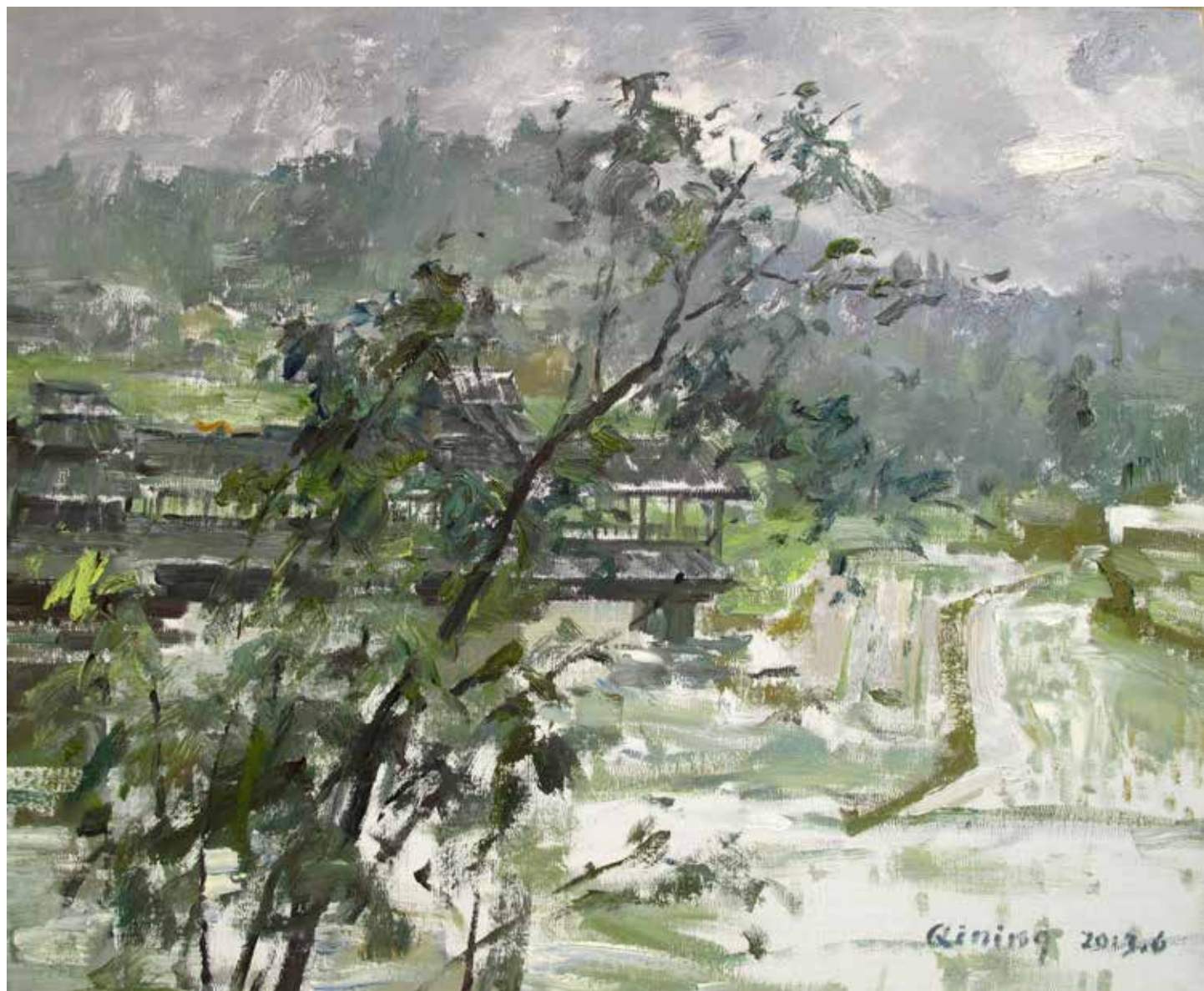


廖扬 / 爸爸妈妈都去哪了 / 版画 / 98×69cm

Liao Yang / Mom and Dad had gone / Print / 98 x 69cm

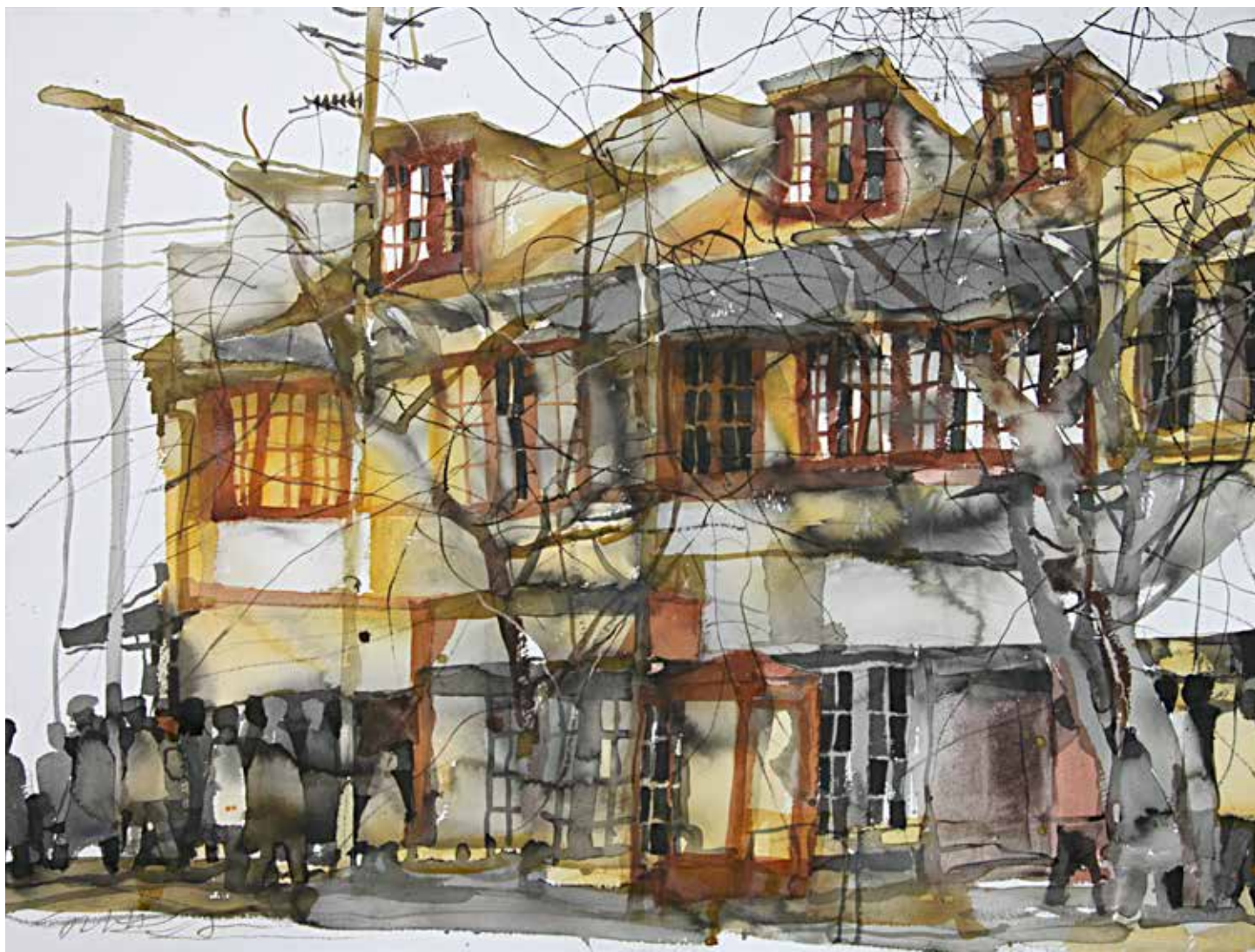

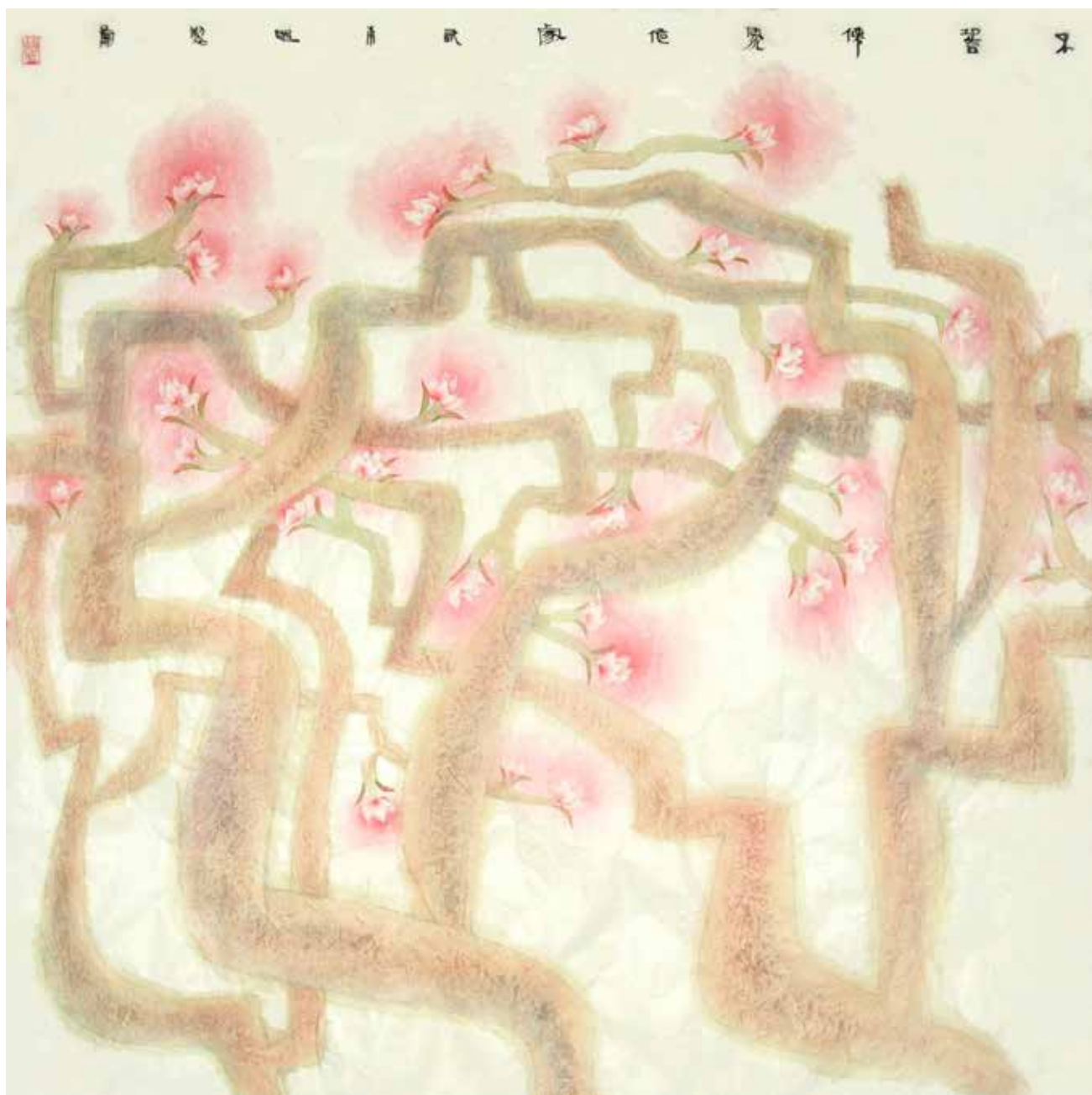

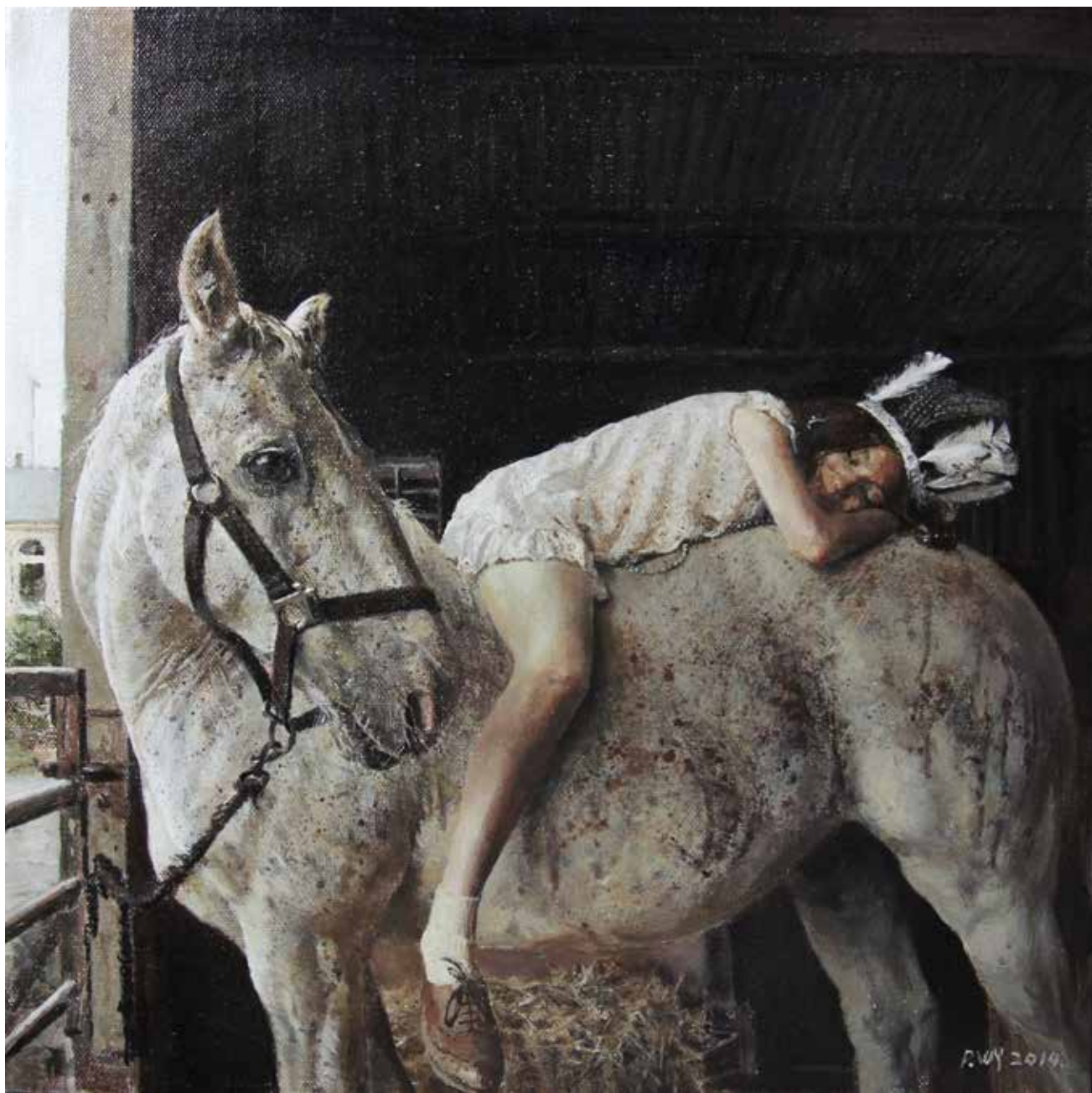

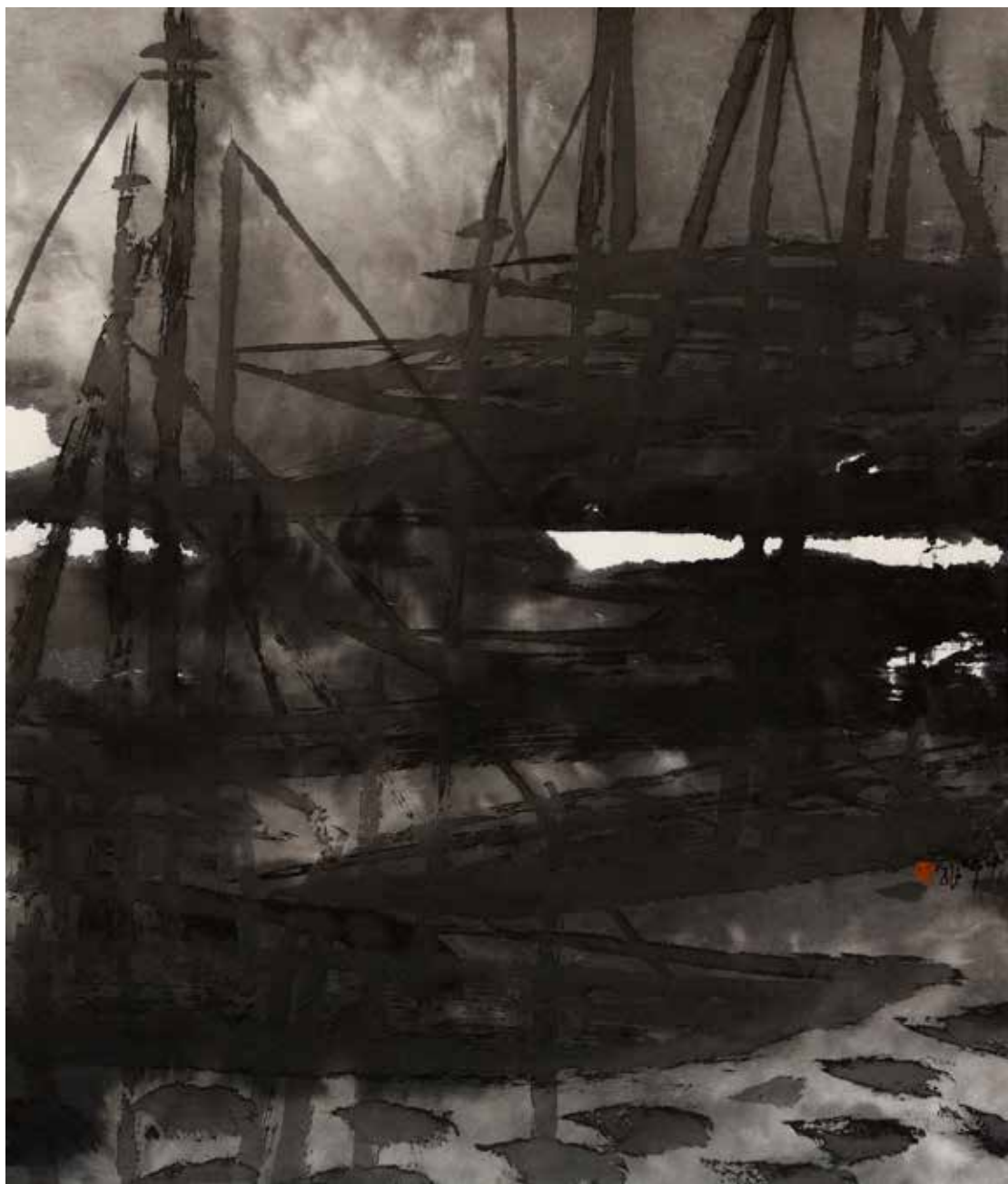

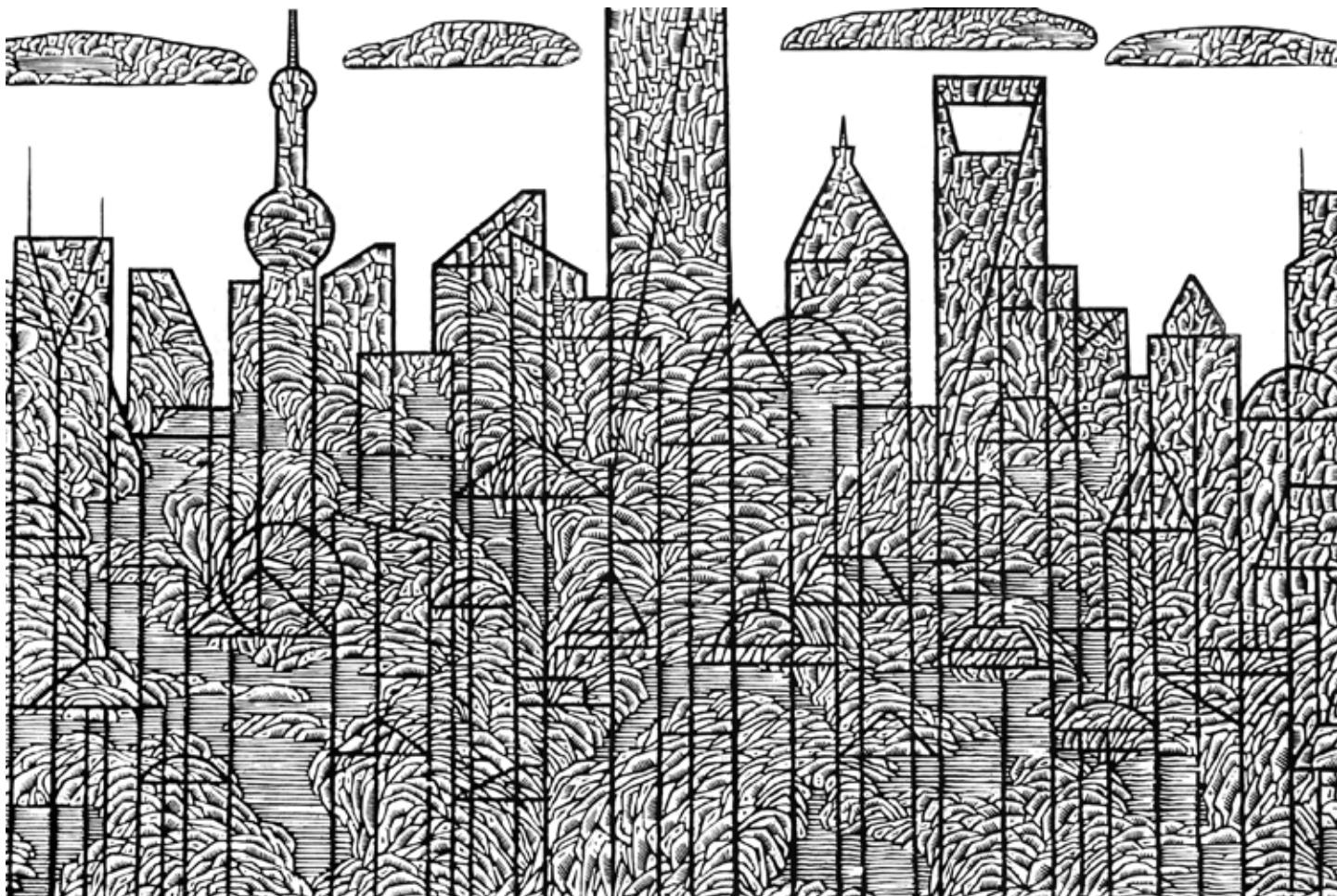

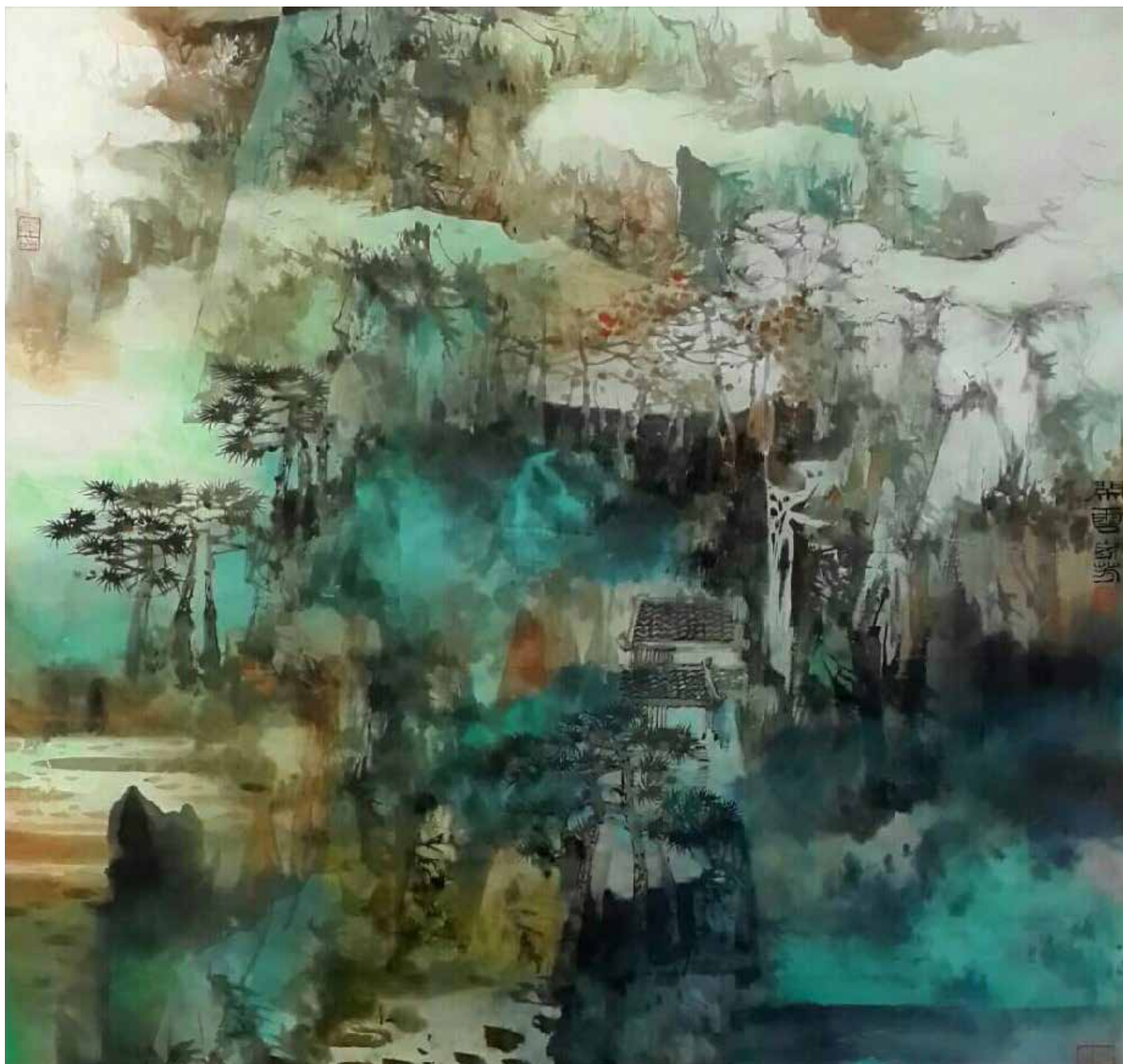

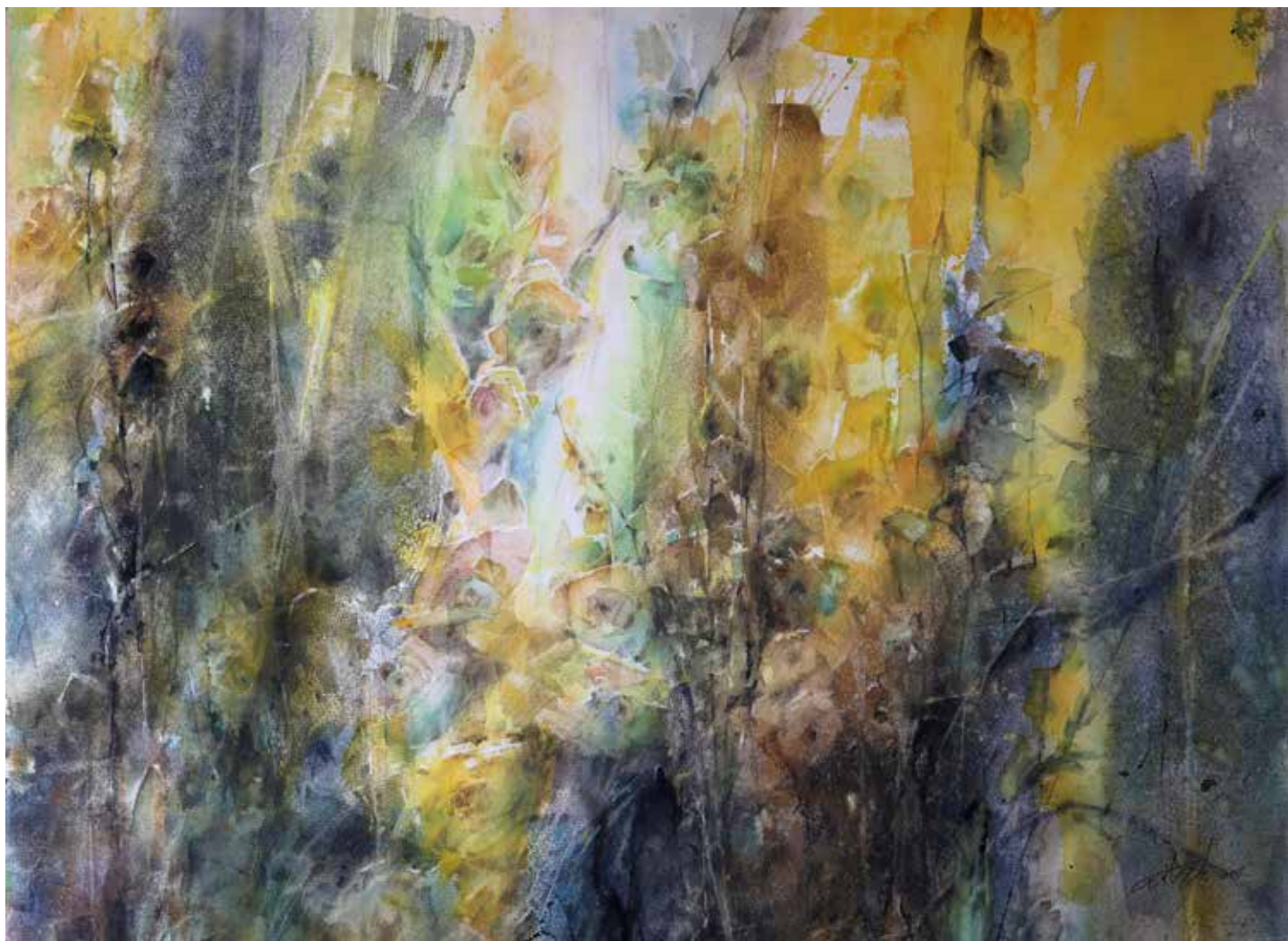
